Habitat for Humanity Seeking Families for 2012 Home Builds in Findlay

November 1, 2011: The Findlay/Hancock County affiliate of Habitat for Humanity is planning for homes to be built in the City of Findlay in 2012, and is seeking their next partner families. Applications are due by December 1, 2011. The application process is open to anyone willing to live in the City of Findlay – and who meet 3 criteria:

1) All Habitat homeowners contribute a minimum of 400 “sweat equity hours” to the construction of their homes and make mortgage payments on no-interest mortgages that go into a revolving fund to help build more houses. 2) Income range for applicants must be between \$19,000 annually (approximately \$366/week) and \$38,000 a year. 3) Families must demonstrate a current need for adequate housing.

If you are a family or know of a family in need of adequate housing because their current living situation is overcrowded, run-down, has high utility bills, or is unsafe – come to the **Habitat Application Event on Sunday, November 13th at 2 pm in the Family Center** located at 1800 N. Blanchard Street, Findlay. Day care will be provided for families to attend a brief half-hour meeting to learn more about Habitat Homeownership, obtain an application, and be provided help to fill out homeownership applications on the spot. All who attend the Habitat Application Event will be entered to win a \$50.00 Gift Certificate provided by Meijer. Drawing will occur on November 13th at event, must be present to win.
